Reporting to the Program Supervisor, the Before and After School Program Educator is responsible for the planning and delivery of inclusive play-based learning and care programs in order to promote the well-being and holistic development of children. The Before and After School Program Educator incorporates the Agency's Mission Statement, Philosophy and Program Statement as well as policies and procedure to ensure the standards of quality care are met.

Key Responsibilities/Duties:

- Registered Early Childhood Educator (or working towards Early Childhood Education) OR Child and Youth Diploma OR Recreation and Leisure Diploma OR B.Ed. (in good standing with The Ontario College of Teachers) or between 6 months - 1 year experience
- Build and maintain caring and responsive relationships with children by engaging in supportive and respectful interactions with children to foster a sense of security and belonging.
- Incorporates observation, pedagogical documentation, planning, implementation and assessment in order to support children's individual and group learning experiences.
- Facilitate cognitive, language, social, emotional, and physical development of children based on inclusion and inquiry and play-based approaches.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills required
- Ability to be flexible and work within the philosophy of the program

- Valid First Aid/CPR for Infant and Children
- Tuberculosis test, doctors note, updated immunization record
- Excellent working knowledge of current Ministry of Education documents including 'How Does Learning Happen', and the Child Care and Early Years Act.
